

## Public Disclosure: Alderson Broaddus University Voluntary Resignation of Accreditation Updated August 25, 2023

Alderson Broaddus University in Philippi, West Virginia, voluntarily resigned its accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission, effective December 31, 2023, due to its upcoming closure.
