Lincoln Christian University Voluntary Resignation of Accreditation

Effective: May 31, 2024

Lincoln Christian University in Lincoln, Illinois, voluntarily resigned its accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission, effective May 31, 2024.

The institution's status as an HLC-accredited institution expires on the effective date above. Credits and degrees earned from the institution through this date remain accredited.
